New Mothers **Inpatient Services**



Northpark Private Hospitals' Mother and Baby Unit provides inpatient programs for families who experience difficulties and adjustment following the arrival of a new baby. The unit can accommodate mothers in the antenatal and postnatal period with their babies and can also provide overnight accommodation for fathers (cost associated).

These difficulties may include:

- Feeding difficulties
- Infant sleeping difficulties
- Unsettled and/or irritable infant
- Reflux and colic
- Ante-natal and post natal anxiety and/or depression.

The unit is staffed by a highly qualified team of Psychiatrists, Pediatricians, Midwives and nurses, specialist Psychiatric Nurses, Psychologists and Social workers, who have extensive experience assisting new mothers and their babies.

Sleep Settling Program: 3 night stay

- The sleep settling program provides education and support strategies for babies with unsettled behaviour or feeding difficulties.
- · Every baby is assessed by a Pediatrician, who in consultation with the nursing staff, will provide an individual care plan.

New Mothers Inpatient Program
